

Croatia Inland Forests & Falls Cycle Route









Building a Sanctuary of Wildlife and Community at Biokovina

After rescuing a wolf, we set out on a remarkable journey to establish Bosnia's first wildlife rehabilitation sanctuary. This sanctuary has become the heart of a variety of inspiring projects, all aimed at creating a sustainable, off-grid haven. From nurturing poly tunnels, planting fruit and nut forests, to creating a space for rescued horses, we're building a self-sustaining future rooted in harmony with nature.

Our mission goes beyond just wildlife. We're crafting a diverse community where people from all walks of life can come together, share ideas, and work toward a common vision. All proceeds from our off-grid rentals support our wildlife charity, so every visitor plays a part in something bigger.

We are situated just 7km from the historic town of Jajce, an area rich with history and brimming with outdoor activities. You'll find a stunning, multi-tiered lake where you can swim beneath powerful waterfalls for a refreshing, natural massage. Jajce itself is home to the world-famous waterfall diving competition, making it a hotspot for adventure. Despite being close to town, Biokovina remains a truly wild and untouched corner of Bosnia—a subsistence farming village nestled in the hills, offering breathtaking views down the valley.

Volunteering here means becoming part of this beautiful, shared experience. We have a large communal space where we live, work, and relax together. Whether you're a guest, a volunteer, or part of our team, we live without separation, encouraging collaboration and connection. And when it's time to unwind, we gather for movie nights or brainstorm new ideas for the sanctuary. Your creativity and input are always welcome!

Animal care - On the wildlife rehabilitation side there are various animals passing through all the time - sometimes as many as 30 and sometimes none. So sometimes we need help and at other times not. Basic nursing care / feeding and cleaning. We also have 5 dogs / 2 cats / chickens / rabbits / guinea pigs and a wolf. All of whom need time and attention / feeding / cleaning.

After the Workaway I catch a bus from Jajces to Belgrade, Serbia. Several companies and time distances 8 to 15 hours.




Transfer to Montenegro Border - Sarajevo to Scepan Polje

Departure station: East Sarajevo (Autobuska Stanica, Lukavica), not the central downtown station Tripadvisor busticket4.me Rome2Rio Tickets: Best purchased in person at the station. Online bookings may require printing and might be rejected if not validated at the station . Platform access fee: Expect to pay ~1 KM to access platforms at East Sarajevo Bus Station .. Likely a small van rather than large coach—comfortable for narrower mountain roads.

Help with gardening and animal care in the beautiful Albanian Alps, in Gusinje, Montenegro

Located in the most beautiful city in Montenegro, valley surrounded by beautiful mountains. Returned home from USA. and looking for someone to help around the house, care about bees, gardening, and enjoy your stay.

Learn about the history of this unique place where 3 religions live side by side for centuries. The village has a very rich history... It was part of the famous Via Ignatia road during the Roman Empire. Most people speak 3 languages. An Example of this is that we are the only city in Montenegro where a catholic church, an orthodox church and a mosque are on the same street. The workaway person will live with me in the house with a private room. We cook together, take care of the garden and help with the bees.

Transfer from Gusinji, Montenegro to Durres, Kosovo

Bus via Deçan or Strellc i Epërm (According to Rome2Rio, the most straightforward route.

Drive or take a taxi/minivan from Gusinje to Deçan or Strellc i Epërm in Kosovo (~45–60 km, 1 h drive) Then take a regional bus to Prizren bus station (approximately 2.5 h ride) Overall travel time: ~3h 30m.

Cost: around €18–€23 total Rome2Rio

This route avoids indirect border crossings and is frequently used by travelers.

Kosovo Workaway







We are a hostel in the centre of the beautiful city of Prizren, Kosovo. We have been opened since 2019 and we have had many guests throughout the years. The idea of our hostel is to invite people from all around the world to exchange and experience each other's cultures and learn new things about Kosovo as it is a hidden gem in Europe.

It is a relaxing and calming environment. There is a kitchen where you can cook and eat together. We have 7 rooms. Some are shared rooms with public bathrooms and some are private rooms with private bathrooms. We have a nice reading area. The hostel is wheelchair friendly.

We have three local employees that work in our hostel. Their roles are manager and two receptionists

We welcome everybody to come and enjoy our place, especially chefs! The staff is nice, friendly and helpful. We will help with recommendations about food and places to visit in the beautiful city of Prizren.

Transfer from Prizren, Kosov to Tirana, Albania

Daily departures: up to 14–17 direct services, starting from 05:30 AM until around 11:30 PM at night.

Duration: Typically 2 h 30 min to 3 h, depending on operator and border processing.

Price: Approx. €10–€15 one way. Taxi to Durres 45 mins 25 Euros


Support rescued animals Durres, Albania

Transfer from Tirana, Albania to Belgrade, Serbia

Direct Bus (Most Affordable)

Frequency: Typically 5 daily departures from Durrës (Plepat station) to Belgrade Bus Station.

Duration: About $12\frac{1}{2}-13\frac{1}{2}$ hours (~775 km).

Cost: Around €32 per ticket.



Border crossing: enjoy relatively seamless routes through Kosovo and Montenegro—bus operators generally handle paperwork.

Russian entry concerns: Serbia does not recognize Kosovo. Some travelers report issues entering Serbia if your passport has a Kosovo stamp from certain crossings—ask your bus operator to advise.


















Avrig to Fagaras




Fagaras to Rupea


